

Canyon Reservoir & Lake Dunlap Advisory
May 23, 2019

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be reducing the river flows to 330 cfs from Canyon Reservoir by 3:30 p.m. this afternoon, Thursday, May 23. This release rate will be maintained through the Memorial Day weekend; however, flows will increase on Tuesday, May 28. At this time, it is not known what the increased release will be.

The lower flows will result in an additional drop in water level at Lake Dunlap. Residents could see an additional 12-inch decline in water level at the dam, with larger level decreases as you move upstream toward I-35. It is anticipated the public boat ramp will be unusable by Friday morning, May 24.
