

A public meeting is being held at the GBRA William E. West, Jr., Annex Building, 905 Nolan, Seguin, Texas 78155 on November 2, 2020 at 9:00am to discuss the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority's Stein Falls Water Reclamation Facility Collection System Expansion in Guadalupe County, Texas. One of the purposes of this meeting is to discuss the potential environmental impacts of the project and alternatives to it.

The project generally involves construction of a gravity main from the Legend Pond lift station, located approximately 0.4 miles southeast of the intersection of West Klein Road and Klein Meadows, to the proposed Grove Lane lift station, located approximately 150 feet southeast of the intersection of FM 725 and Grove Lane, and a proposed force main from the proposed lift station to the Stein Falls Water Reclamation Facility, located approximately 0.7 miles east of the intersection of Schumans Beach Road and FM 725.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$21,460,000. At this time, no increase to rates or connection fees is anticipated to finance this proposed project. An application for financial assistance for the project has been filed with the Texas Water Development Board, P.O. Box 13231, Austin, Texas, 78711-3231. This project involves construction of a critical facility in the 100-year floodplain and construction located in a wetland. Alternatives to construction in a floodplain/wetland, potential impacts of floodplains/wetlands and proposed mitigation measures will be addressed during the public meeting.
