Subjects to be considered for discussion at such meeting include:

1. Appointment of a Nominating Committee for Officers of the Board of Directors for calendar year 2018.

3. Consideration of and possible action approving the minutes of the October 18, 2017, Board meeting.
4. Consideration of and possible action approving the monthly financial report for September and October 2017.
5. Consideration of and possible action approving the monthly operations report for October 2017.
6. Consideration of and possible action approving Directors' expense vouchers.
7. Consideration of and possible action approving the disposal of equipment in accordance with GBRA Board Policy 411-Capital Assets.

ACTION ITEMS

9. Consideration of and possible action authorizing the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for installation of the Martindale flood sirens in Caldwell County.
10. Consideration of and possible action authorizing the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute a contract with an engineering firm for the design of a replacement gate at the Guadalupe Valley Hydroelectric System H-5 (Lake Wood) Dam in Gonzales County.
11. Consideration of and possible action authorizing the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute a contract with the City of Buda for operation of the Buda Wastewater Treatment Plant.
12. Consideration of and possible action on a Resolution confirming authority to negotiate and execute the Purchase Sale Agreement with San Jose Water for the purchase of Texas Water Alliance (TWA) and

all related documents, and authorizing the General Manager/CEO to execute all documents needed to complete the sale of Texas Water Alliance to GBRA, the assumption of all TWA assets and obligations, and the dissolution of TWA.

13. Consideration of and possible action to approve a Resolution appointing officers for Texas Water Alliance to act on behalf of Texas Water Alliance and the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority relating to the winding down and termination of Texas Water Alliance, adoption of a Plan of Winding Up and Termination for Texas Water Alliance, and the transfer and assumption of Texas Water Alliance assets and obligations to the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority.

15. Discussion regarding Base Flow Report, Water Quality Index, long term weather pattern, and condition of the Guadalupe Basin.

ITEMS FOR EXECUTIVE SESSION

16. The Board may meet in Executive Session as authorized by the listed sections of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, to discuss the following matters:

a. advice from legal counsel about pending or contemplated litigation, proposed settlements, and the impact of pending or contemplated litigation on GBRA projects and proposed projects. This includes without limitation, the following matters: *LULAC v. Edwards Aquifer Authority* (United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division); *NBL-300 Group v GBRA*, (4th Court of Appeals, San Antonio) Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality by GBRA for GBRA's Mid-Basin surface water permit (State Office of Administrative Hearings); Applications to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for bed and banks permits in the San Antonio and Guadalupe River Basins, including applications filed by New Braunfels Utilities and San Antonio Water Systems; GBRA application to amend Certificate of Adjudication No. 18-3863; Other contested applications to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality by GBRA for water rights or amendments to water rights; Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;

b. briefing and advice from legal counsel relating to ongoing negotiations, potential liabilities and other matters covered by legal counsel's duty of confidentiality; Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;

c. deliberation on matters relating to the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property interests and advice from legal counsel on those matters, including without limitation issues relating to acquisition of additional office space for GBRA in Comal County, rights and obligations under the agreement to purchase groundwater rights in Gonzales and Caldwell Counties for GBRA's Carrizo Groundwater Project, legal and regulatory issues relating to the acquisition and ownership of those water rights, and other groundwater and surface water rights owned by or contemplated for purchase or lease by GBRA; Sections 551.071 and 551.072, Texas Government Code;

d. advice from legal counsel on matters relating to safety regulations, and construction regulations associated with GBRA-owned or operated reservoirs; Section 551.071 and 551.072, Texas Government Code;

e. advice from legal counsel on matters relating to the solicitation, receipt, opening, and/or evaluation of requests for proposals, requests for qualifications, and bids, and relating to the actions taken or supposed to be taken by GBRA on such bids; and possible settlement of all such matters; Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;

f. commercial or financial information, including without limitation GBRA's Lower Basin Project, GBRA's Carrizo Groundwater Project; Section 551.087, Texas Government Code;

g. appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee; Section 551.074, Texas Government Code.

The Board may take final action on any of the above mentioned matters while convened in open session pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
