b. advice from legal counsel about pending litigation and/or threatened litigation relating to right of way acquisition; deliberation on matters relating to the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property interests and advice from legal counsel on those matters, including without limitation issues relating to (i) right-of-way acquisitions for GBRA-related projects within the boundaries of GBRA; and (ii) exchange, sale, or transfer of real property interests within the boundaries of GBRA; Section 551.071 and 551.072, Texas Government Code;
